



Resident Scholarship Application 2009-10 Academic Year

Instructions:

Submit the complete scholarship application, including verification of financial information, a complete application for resident membership and a current résumé to the Admissions Office by June 12, 2009. If you have any questions, please contact the Admissions Office by phone at (212) 316-8436 or e-mail at mamouzou@ihouse-nyc.org. The Admissions Committee will review applications between June 12 and late-July 2009. By submitting this application the Admissions Committee will consider you for the following scholarship programs based on the eligibility criteria described below.

Eligibility criteria:

The principal factors in determining scholarship awards are demonstrated financial need and interest in contributing to the I. House community through participation in its programs. Additional selection criteria for specific awards are described below.

- ◆ **Outreach Grants:** Awards ranging from \$500 to \$3,000 for qualified applicants applying to live at I. House for the first time. Priority is given to applicants from countries, fields of study or backgrounds that are under-represented in the I. House community.
- ◆ **Mitsui USA Foundation Grant:** One person will be selected to receive \$5,000 for the academic year. The program was developed to foster educational efforts that promote international understanding and closer U.S.-Japan relations. Qualified applicants should be U.S. citizens or permanent residents and have an interest in international affairs or business.
- ◆ **Performing Artists in Residence Program:** Four musicians, dancers or actors who are applying to live at International House for the first time will receive a scholarship of \$5,000 each for the academic year. Recipients will be required to make a significant programmatic contribution throughout the academic year.
- ◆ **McLaine East/Central European Leadership Program:** Awards ranging from \$1,000 to \$3,000 for residents from East and Central Europe. The McLaine program is designed to encourage interaction among residents from East and Central Europe and offer programming about the region for the entire I. House community.
- ◆ **Frontiers Management Consulting Grant:** A grant up to \$3,000 will be awarded to one person from an emerging country who will be studying business or business related field. Awards are based on demonstrated financial need and a willingness to contribute to I. House. This grant is made possible through the generous donation of Frontiers Management Consulting based in Frankfurt, Germany.

Although you may be eligible for more than one of the above programs it is only possible to receive **one**.

Please be sure you have included all required attachments listed in the checklist. Award of a scholarship is contingent on admission and you will not learn of the scholarship decision prior to the admission decision.
