I-House Bicycle Parking/Storage Policy

The International House provides a bicycle storage room which is located on the B-Floor of I-House South. Pending the availability of space, bicycles may be stored at no cost to the resident. Only resident and staff members of the I-House Community can bring bicycles on I-House premises.

Only registered bicycles may be stored in the bicycle storage room. Resident members may register their bicycles with the Office of Public Safety, via the on-duty House Manager. Unregistered bicycles will be removed and discarded. At the conclusion of the Spring Semester, unclaimed bicycles and unregistered bicycles will be disposed.

The bicycle storage room is used and accessed by many residents. I-House is not responsible for stored bicycles that are lost, stolen, or damaged. Resident members may wish to consider purchasing property insurance to cover the potential loss or damage of a bicycle.

Bicycle Parking Where Permitted: Bicycles shall be parked, stored or left in one designated area (B-Level Bike Storage Room)

Unauthorized Storage Prohibited: No bicycle shall be parked, stored, or left in the B-Level Bike Storage room unless it is properly registered and parked in its designated space. Any unregistered bike parked in a space will be subject to immediate removal by Site Operations staff.

Parking or Storing Inside of Buildings: No bicycle shall be parked, stored or left in any lobby, hallway or common area on I-House grounds.

Blocking Entrances – Exits Prohibited: No person shall park, store or leave a bicycle in such a manner as to block or otherwise impede normal entrance to or exit from any I-House building entrance.

Locking to Unauthorized Objects: No bicycle shall be chained or otherwise locked or attached to any part of the I-House tree planter boxes, I-House gating, fencing or canopy support poles.

Removal of Bicycles in Violation: Whenever a bicycle:

- Blocks or otherwise impedes the normal movement of persons with disabilities and other pedestrians or equipment on exits, entrances, sidewalks or patios;
- Is parked in violation of any section within this policy;
- Appears to be abandoned as evidenced by signs of disuse or neglect;
- Has been reported as stolen to any law enforcement agency.

The International House Site Operations staff is authorized to move, relocate or immobilize the bicycle. I-House personnel are authorized to impound bicycles by removing the securing mechanism using whatever reasonable measures are necessary. I-House is not liable for the cost of repair, replacement of the securing device or for the damaged caused to the bicycle.
