Financial Aid Opportunities

Deadline: March 8, 2019

Applications for need-based financial aid for the 2019-20 academic year are now available. All current resident members planning to return next year are eligible to apply for financial aid.

- **Dodge Foundation Fund** Awards up to \$6,500 from the Middle East or those from elsewhere who are studying Middle Eastern Affairs.
- **General Resident Fund** Awards ranging from \$500 to \$6,500 will be made to Residents who have lived at I-House for at least one semester.
- **Fund II Foundation Fund** Awards up to \$10,000 for the academic year will be awarded to African American and African Residents with demonstrated financial need. The Fund II Foundation has chosen to partner with I-House and the extraordinary residents to further their mission of illuminating the richness of Black history and culture, advancing social change and creating an enduring American legacy.
- **Leslie H. Gelb Fund** Awards of up to \$5,000 will be given to Residents studying Journalism or International Affairs. Named in honor of Mr. Gelb who has a long and distinguished career with the New York Times and then as a senior Defense and State Department official.
- **Mitsui USA Foundation Fund** Awards of \$5,000 will be made to 1-3 Residents who are U.S. citizens or permanent residents. Made possible by The Mitsui USA Foundation, the program was developed to foster educational efforts that promote international understanding and closer U.S.-Japan relations. Qualified applicants should have strong communication skills and an interest in international affairs or business.
- **The Thea Petschek Iervolino Foundation** Awards of \$7,500 each to 2 residents studying art, 2 residents studying music and 1 resident studying education. Thea Petschek Iervolino, '48 was an avid patron of the arts and International House. She has expressed her life-long commitment to International House in various ways including the generous support allowing for financial aid awards.
- **Toyota Motor Corporation Fund** Awards ranging from \$500 to \$6,500 will be awarded to those from Japan and other Asian countries and/or those studying a technical field such as engineering.
- **Welcome Fund** Open to Residents demonstrating financial need whose personal circumstances have been adversely impacted by a negative political climate in their home country or in the United States. This fund is made possible by the generous support of I-House Trustees, Alumni, and Friends strongly committed to the I-House mission.

There is one application for all of the funds listed above. *Although you may be eligible for more than one it is only possible to receive one.*
