Readmission 2019-2020

Are you planning to return to I-House next year?

As we begin to plan an exciting year of programming and community engagement for next year, we need to be aware of your plans! As a current resident, you may apply for readmission if you are in good standing and have lived at I-House for less than three academic years. If you are currently an intern or trainee, you are not eligible for readmission unless you will be in a full-time graduate program next academic year. We strongly encourage you to apply even if your plans are not certain or if you cannot provide verification of eligibility as you will have until mid-July to finalize your plans and/or provide verification.

A robust program of events is being planned for your enjoyment. You can expect weekly high-profile events including guest speakers, documentary film screenings (which include a discussion with the filmmakers), workshops and seminars for personal and professional development and a wide variety of other programs. All residents are expected to attend **at least four programs** per semester to remain in good standing. Programs that count toward the requirement include guest speakers, documentary film screenings, round table discussions, workshops and seminars.

To be considered for readmission you must complete the Interpersonal Integrity workshop.

Deadlines:

March 8, 2019 to receive priority in room selection

May 15, 2019 to receive priority in admission over new applicants
Applications received after May 15 will automatically be placed on the waiting list
